

How-to Start a “Cross in the window” campaign

This is super easy! And it allows kids to participate. As many are out walking, it allows them to be encouraged and see people aren't afraid to share that they are seeking the Lord and praying to Him during this time. It might even get someone to ask, “Why are there these crosses?” and that is a great opening for a powerful conversation.



All you need to do is

1. Print copies of the next page
2. Provide them to residents. We had them available on the front porch of certain homes and also posted a link to the blank cross on Facebook
3. Ask them to post so that those walking by will be encouraged knowing people in those homes are praying for the neighborhood
4. We learned over time to
 - a. Offer some crosses that were already colored as some people don't have crayons/markers to color them with
 - b. Encourage people to ask the neighborhood kids to help color them
 - c. Have reminders about it on Facebook and link posting the crosses to other events
