We have used notes on doors, banners and primarily a Facebook group. These are shown below.

Below is the original note left on people's doors during a prayer walk:

I prayed for you and your family as I walked by your home - for peace, protection and unity. These are tough times, and God is still on the throne.

Then I posted on the subdivision Facebook page, telling them about the door posting above and encouragement walls (see other pdf).

The leadership team then decided to create a private Facebook Group. This is a place people can go for prayer, encouragement, and to share needs. For that we put postings on the regular subdivision Facebook page and also invited people directly. Finally, we put banners up in the subdivision (which we unfortunately had to take down after a complaint, but I would still try it).

Facebook Group

This is what the group looks like. Two of our leaders are administrators.

There are daily posts to the main page for encouragement. The prayer co-leaders post on Monday and Thursday asking specifically for gratitude's on Monday and answered prayer on Thursdays.



We posted links to forms in the "about" section so people know how to get help or volunteer. Make sure it is clear that instructions are located here before the "more."




